The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m., by President, Riley Chaney. A quorum was at all times present and acting.

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7. GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Mr. Amorelli presented his verbal report encompassing operations, maintenance, projects and other District matters for the month of February, 2024, as follows:

OPERATIONS

- ▶ <u>Water Deliveries: February, 2024</u> Water deliveries for the month of February were 1,259 acre-feet which is 325 acre-feet more than was delivered during February, 2023. The fiscal year-to-date total deliveries are at 45,760 acre-feet which is 9,724 acre-feet less than was delivered at this time during the last fiscal year.
- Kings River Water Association
 - <u>KRWA Storage Operations in Pine Flat Reservoir</u> as of March 4, 2024, totaled 1,420 CFS-days.

PROJECTS

Community Solar - Met with Golden State Clean Energy, LLC, (GSR) and John Rider, a grower who specializes in "repurposing" fallowed agricultural lands, to explore a possible project. GSR has 20,000+ acres under development in the Westlands Solar Park in Westlands Water District. They acknowledged conveying power outside the District is problematic due to insufficient PG&E transmission capacity; however, there may be other opportunities for the District to investigate.

AGENCIES

- San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority (SLDMWA) had intended to work on the O'Neill Pumping Plant during April-May which resulted in objections from several contractors. The project may be postponed to November when demand is lower.
- <u>Kings Basin GSA Coordinating Committee</u> continues to deliberate policies for (1) domestic well mitigation, (2) interconnected waterways and (3) subsidence issues. As additional data is needed, their goal is complete these components by the end of 2024.
- Raisin City Water District (RCWD) Met with RCWD ad hoc representatives on February 23rd to explore the potential to collaborate on items of mutual interest/benefit.

ACTIVITIES

Valley Water (Santa Clara Valley Water) representatives recently toured the District to explore potential partnership opportunities.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

STORM Water Resource Management Software / Online Portal - Information has been e-mailed to growers enabling them to set-up account access through the STORM online portal. Irrigation ordering has been activated. The goal is to have online payment submission activated April, 2024. Growers will be advised when educational workshops are scheduled.

Superintendent, Kenneth Mancini, reported the field staff are finishing the following projects:

- Reviewed District Crop Plan, noting an estimated 1,381± acres are projected to be fallowed this season equating to a potential reduction of 5,000 acre-feet in irrigation deliveries.
- Mr. Amorelli reiterated solar credits are applicable only to power consumption charges and not standby charges and are greatly reduced during wet years like 2023 when power consumption is greatly reduced.
