- ▶ <u>Water Deliveries: October, 2023</u> Water deliveries for the month of October were 2,983 acre-feet which is 156 acre-feet more than was delivered during October, 2022. The fiscal year-to-date total deliveries are at 42,572 acre-feet which is 11,004 acre-feet less than was delivered at this time during the last fiscal year.
- Kings River Water Association
 - <u>KRWA Storage Operations in Pine Flat Reservoir</u> as of November 5, 2023, totaled 1,135 CFS-days.

▶ <u>Well Repairs</u> - Welljet arrived October 30th and began rehabilitation of wells D-70 and D-79.

- Excavator Mr. Amorelli reviewed excavator quotes ranging from \$125,781/used-track to \$407,846/new-wheeled. A wheeled unit is currently being rented. In response to comments from Superintendent Mancini indicating the District's needs are limited and may not justify the purchase of an additional excavator, it was the consensus of the Board to continue renting units as needed.
- <u>Backhoe</u> Mr. Mancini stated having three backhoes has been of great benefit as all units are continually in use. He requested the Board consider trading in one unit on a new backhoe next year, budget permitting. Mr. Amorelli will secure bids for consideration next meeting.
