## III. ACTION ITEMS

## A. FLOOD & EXCESS WATER DELIVERIES (03/14/2023)

Subsequent to the Board's decision to charge the District's standard O&M rate (currently \$175.00/acre-foot) for deliveries of flood and/or excess water outside District boundaries (Min: 03/14/2023), Mr. Amorelli noted staff as well as Board members had received feedback from growers objecting/indicating that the price should be lowered.

Board members commented as follows:

- Charging \$175.00/acre-foot is too high.
- Reconsider previous decision; work with neighbors.

Mr. Parra inquired if there is a potential for flood water to be made available for on-farm recharge as well as irrigation purposes which would benefit boron/salt percolation. General Manager, Manny Amorelli, responded there is currently limited interest due to wet weather.

In consideration of the anticipated positive impact utilization of flood water will have in reducing power & procurement costs, the Board requested the 2023-2024 Fiscal Budget be revisited monthly to evaluate the potential to lower the billing rate from \$175/acre-foot. Active discussion ensued. Ultimately, if/when a rate adjustment is decided, agreed it should be made retroactive to March 1, 2023.
