The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m., by President, Riley Chaney. A quorum was at all times present and acting.

Members of the public were encouraged to access the meeting via internet/Zoom or use the call-in number to allow them to fully participate in the meeting without having to be present.

IV. ACTION ITEMS

A. MAIN CANAL FEASIBILITY STUDY (12/14/2021)

General Manager, Manny Amorelli, expressed appreciation to all attending in person and remotely for their interest and participation in this meeting.

► Eric Abrahamsen and Brian Ehlers, Provost & Pritchard Consulting (P&P), reviewed the draft "Main Canal Feasibility Study", September, 2022, which was charged "to investigate necessary improvements to its Main Canal check/booster structures to gain the ability to increase structure flow capacity. Through the analysis, P&P determined that the existing

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check structures along the Main Canal are at or [have] surpassed their useful life and should be replaced with new structures and equipment."

- Mr. Ehlers noted they were uncertain of the District's goals and indicated the cost of replacement will be dependent on the desired rate of flow. He noted structures can be designed to allow for larger pumps but the draft report assumes all will be replaced. The Main Canal can accommodate a maximum flow of 400 CFS (currently averages 300 CFS); however, constrictions at Floral, Boosters E and P are impeding flow. The Board indicated the District's goal is to capture more floodwater when available.
- Also, discussed observations regarding the P&P report provided by Dr. Charles Burt, Irrigation Training & Research Center, Cal/Poly San Luis Obispo.

A very robust period of discussion ensued during which various design/cost options were explored. Provost & Pritchard was requested to update the Main Canal Feasibility Study to maximize Main Canal flow rate at 400 CFS by:

- Performing necessary surveys.
- Providing calculations on alternate designs.
- Developing a schedule for phased construction for future planning.
- Investigating availability of grant funding.
- Monthly progress reports were requested for each Regular Board Meeting.

The Board expressed appreciation to all in attendance for contributing to this "brainstorming" effort.
