The fiscal year-to-date total deliveries are at 43,872 acre-feet which is 10,677 acre-feet less than was delivered at this time during the last fiscal year.
- <u>Kings River Water Association</u>
 - <u>KRWA Storage Operations in Pine Flat Reservoir</u> as of December 3, 2023, totaled 1,413 CFS-days.
