 Evaluate highest/best use for RD1606 properties (farm/grazing vs. recharge, solar/wind, etc.) and plan accordingly.
- <u>Communication</u>
 - The importance of maintaining clear lines of communication between Boards was reiterated in order to share visions and to unify goals/plans.
 - Both boards expressed an interest in continuing discussions and agreed to future joint meetings (2/year).
